This is how it works:

1. The "This is us" voice message: Introduce yourself briefly: Who are you, where are you from? What are you looking forward to at WoidLa24? A voice message could sound something like this: "Hello, we are the Rangers and Rovers from Salzburg and there are ten of us at WoidLa24. We are particularly looking forward to WoidLa24, because at camps you always get to know lots of scouts from other countries."
2. The "Our specialty" voice message: You are also welcome to be creative and tell us what makes your scout group/your home town/yourselves special ("We from Bad Vöslau are always the last ones at morning sports", "We in Bad Vöslau make the biggest campfires", "The Vöslauer mineral water comes from us in Bad Vöslau."
3. The "Word Rap" voice messages (Please state the question first! – Preferably as a poll with several answers on one question (#passonthephone)).



In addition, you can answer the following questions, each individually in a voice message per question:

- o What do you always forget at the camp / What shouldn't you forget at WoidLa24?
- o What was your funniest camp experience?
- o What was your most embarrassing camp experience?
- o Wearing the same underpants for the whole camp: No Go or No Problem?
- o What is your absolute no-go in the tent?

ATTENTION, for us to be able to assign the voice messages: First of all, please send us a short identifying message from you (i.e. who you are - please as a WhatsApp text), which we can match with your sender phone number - otherwise we won't know who sent us which audio files. We only need the first name and your scout group!
